 these presents Sealed with our Seals and Dated the 18th day of
 October 1794

The Condition of the above obligation is such that ~~if~~ whereas there
 is a Marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between Simon Marshall
 and Katy Stickle for which a License hath issued Now if there
 be no lawful cause to obstruct the said intended Marriage then
 the above obligation to be void, else to remain in full force.
