Your letter of 6-Jan 1917
duly rec^d but I am sorry
to relate that Father is so
sick with his old complaint
that he is unable to do
anything but remain quiet
and can hardly get around
the house without exerting
himself, but he is recovering
slowly, but will give you
all the information that
Father knows of.

Cornelius W. Williams Son
your Uncle Mother's name was
Sarah Border.

Father says that as soon
as he gets better or able he
would be pleased to correspond

John Williams was captured
by the British and confined
on Duane & Rose st in what
was then the Sugar house
Captured in Jersey

The names that must of
fought in the Revolution
was John, Noah, Cordius,
Henry, David, Squire

Squire house is where the
British Bayoneted the red
and took Expiel and through
him off the floor and ~~down~~
him and being so young
they left him

John was given powder by the
British but did not

take them the doctor came
in every day to see how
he was getting along
and he was getting along
so nice that he met with
favor with the King so he
put him in the King Garden
he watched his chance and
to a row boat and escaped to
jersey shore
